

Seventh Circuit Parent Orientation Program

NOTICE: Orientation Requirement

Local Court Rule 68.7 requires you to complete a parent orientation program if:

- ▶ You are a party in a paternity establishment case (COPE Too)
- ▶ You are a party in a Dissolution (divorce) and have a child/ren of the marriage under age 18 (COPE program)
- ▶ You are a party in a Legal Separation and have a child/ren of the marriage under age 18 (COPE program)
- ▶ You are a party in a Modification that involves a possible change in residential custody and/or parenting time with a child/ren under age 18. (COPE & Beyond)
- ▶ You are a party in a motion for family access involving a child/ren under age 18 (COPE & Beyond)
- ▶ You are otherwise ordered by a judge to complete a parent orientation program.

A Petitioner shall attend within 45 days of the filing of the original petition.

A Respondent shall attend within 45 days after service of process.

No additional fee is required to attend the program once the case is filed.

You must attend the entire program to obtain a certificate of completion.
