Directions to Clerk

The name of all parties must be included in the caption. The date to be inserted from which the 45 days begin to run is the date of the first publication. If the plaintiff/petitioner has no attorney, the order of publication of notice must recite the address of the plaintiff/petitioner. Only the object and general nature of the civil action is to be stated, for example "for dissolution of marriage." The clerk is required within 10 days after order for service of publication of notice is entered, to mail a copy of the notice and a copy of the petition to any defendant/respondent at the address given in the verified statement (affidavit) or petition filed by the party desiring service by publication. The clerk is also required to file a certificate that a copy of the notice and a copy of the petition were mailed to each defendant/respondent and the date of each mailing. An affidavit shall also be filed showing the publication dates and the name of the newspaper in which the notice was published. A copy of the published notice shall be attached to the affidavit.
