

Where

An action can be filed at the courthouse:

- In the county where you live;
- In the county where the abuse or stalking occurred; **or**
- In the county where the stalker/abuser may be served.



Ex Parte

After filing an action, if the judge finds you are in **immediate and present danger** of abuse or stalking, the court may issue an Ex Parte Order of Protection for no more than 15 days. Then a hearing will be held for the possibility of an order that can last up to one year.

Orders of Protection



The Missouri Adult Abuse Act
Mo. Rev. Stat. §§455.005– 455.090

Under Missouri's Adult Abuse Act, you must meet the following requirements:

Age

You must be **one** of the following:

- At least 17 years old; **or**
- Emancipated.

Relationship

Are **one** of the following:

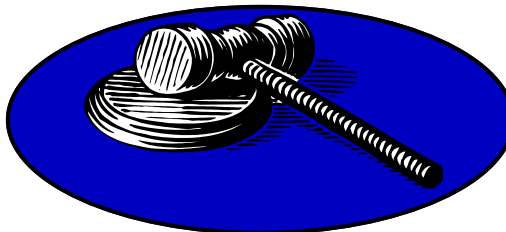
- Spouses or former spouses;
- Persons related by blood or marriage;
- Persons residing together or have resided with each other;
- Adults who have a child together regardless of marriage or cohabitation;
- Persons in a continuing social relationship of a romantic or intimate nature; **or**
- The victim of stalking.

You must have been stalked or subjected to domestic violence to receive an order of protection.

Stalking

You have been stalked when the stalker:

- Purposely and repeatedly engaged in an unwanted pattern of conduct that caused a reasonable fear of physical harm.



Abuse

You have been abused when the abuser does **one** of the following:

- Placed or attempted to place you in fear of physical harm;
- Caused you physical harm;
- Forced or threatened to force you to engage in conduct you have a right to restrain or restrain you from conduct you have a right to engage;
- Caused you to engage involuntarily in any sexual act by force or threat of force;
- Purposely engaged, more than once, in harassing conduct that causes you substantial emotional distress;
- Held, confined, detained or abducted you against your will.
